Observations noted during the visits includes:

1. Comparatively good infrastructure.
2. Poor teacher profile.
3. Poor student attendance/activities.
4. Dual office bearers.
5. Poor administrative support.

Recommendations suggested as mentor institution to the mentee institution

1. Faculty enrichment exercises (Improved service conditions, FIPs/FDPs).
2. Strengthening of student support services.
3. Generation of resources.
4. ICT skilled managerial staff.
5. Strengthening of IQACs.
