1. On the spot counseling round against the intake seats at CASAS of New Arts, Commerce and Science College for the academic programmes of the year 2026-27 will be carried as per the merit list based on 30 % of entrance marks and 70% in qualifying exams (H.Sc. exam)
2. The students interested to participate in the round are required to read the instructions given below carefully and report as per above mentioned schedule.
3. The tentative sequences of activities to be followed on the day of counseling are given below:

Sr. No.	Activity
1	Reporting to Main Auditorium(Rajarshri Shahu Maharaj Auditorium), New Arts Commerce and Science College, Ahmednagar (Refer Counselling Round Time Table)
2	Verification of applicable original documents as notified .
3	Call for seat allotment by counseling as per Merit List.
4	Sorting of requisition for seat allotment. Seat allotment based on available intake.
5	Submission of required original documents .
6	Confirmation of the allotted seat to the candidate.
7	Payment of Admission Confirmation Fees Rs.2000/- (Rs. Two Thousand) by cash or Online.(Nonrefundable if not taken admission within the given time limit.)
8	Issue of allotment letter to the candidate.

4. Candidate will lose claim to participate in the admission counseling process, if he/she fails to produce **ALL** the applicable original documents at the time of document verification during counseling round. In case a candidate has taken admission elsewhere he/she will be required to submit/produce original fee receipt and the candidate should submit undertaking stating that original documents will be submitted by him/her during the given time period for confirmation of admission i.e. **23/6/2026 to 30/6/2026**
5. The admissions will be made strictly in the order of inter-se merit amongst the candidates who report in person for admission against the seats available in various **academic programmes** offered by CASAS.
6. If the number of candidates present for counselling round exceeds the given vacancies, then the remaining candidates will be considered for waiting list.
7. Candidates who have secured seat in counselling round (both open and reservation) must confirm their seat by paying fees of Rs.2000/- (Non Refundable) in cash or ONLINE payment. Such candidate is given provisional admission for the academic programmes of his / her choice. Admission will be confirmed after paying the prescribed full college admission fees (no installment payment is allowed for final confirmation of admission) from **23/6/2026 to 30/6/2026**
8. Confirmation of the allotted seat to the candidate is subject to the submission of the College fees and applicable original documents. If the candidate fails to complete the procedure within the given time his/ her admission claim and provisional admission letter will be cancelled.
8. If a candidate fails to pay the requisite college fee or fails to produce the applicable documents in original, after the seat allotment, such candidature will be withdrawn and the seat will be allotted to the next candidate on the merit list by communicating through email-id/phone number.
9. After filling all the vacant seats, the procedure will be terminated.
10. Candidates who have applied for CET under CASAS and attempted the CET

held on 18/06/2026 will be considered for merit list. Admissions will be confirmed as per the intake seats in CASAS excluding management quota.

11. The seat allotment will be carried out based on the vacancy status at that point. Seat allotted, accordingly, to a candidate would then be deleted from the pool of vacant seats displayed on the auditorium screen. Candidates are advised to be present in the Counseling hall and wait for their turn as per inter-se merit. If a candidate is found unavailable when called, the next candidate on the merit rank would be called for allotment of seat, the unavailable candidate may miss his/her chance of merit based seat allotment.
12. If a candidate of higher merit reports late (valid reason) during the process of counseling, the candidate may be considered for allotment of a seat available at that point of time for a particular category to which he/she belongs. Such a candidate shall be given preference for admission over the candidates with lower rank present at that point of time. The decision of the admission center in-charge shall be final and binding to applicant.
13. If a candidate fails to submit original documents as per the given list and / or admission fees from **23/6/2026 to 30/6/2026**, the candidature for such candidate will be cancelled. Such candidates cannot claim the seat thereafter.
14. After allotment of seat, candidate will be issued an allotment letter duly signed by the Authority of CASAS along with the Stamp of CASAS. The allotted academic programme as requested by the candidate is final and cannot be altered later.
15. Candidates who have been allotted seat by merit, should not leave the venue of counseling without the allotment letter duly signed by the authority of CASAS. The candidate is advised to check the details as printed/written in the allotment letter.
16. The physical presence of the candidate at the time of Counseling is mandatory. If a candidate is unable to be physically present for the Counseling due to unavoidable circumstances, he/she may authorize his/her

parent/guardian to represent him/her for the counseling round. The candidate or the authorized representative of the candidate must carry all the applicable documents in original, provision for paying admission confirmation fees Rs.2000/- in cash / online, an Authorization Letter duly signed by the candidate and the representative, and candidate's as well as the parent/guardian's Photo Identity card in original. Absence of the candidate or his/her authorized representative at the indicated counseling venue may result in the forfeiture of his/her claim for a seat as per his/her merit rank. The authorization letter will be collected by the admission center In-charge.

17. In case the parent/guardian is representing the candidate, the seat choice made by the parent/guardian will be final and binding on the candidate. No claim will be entertained later on.

18. In case of cancellation of confirmed admission later, **college fee paid for confirmation of the admission by the candidate will not be refunded under any circumstances.** Returning of applicable original documents submitted by such candidates at the time of seat allotment will be carried out within one working day after the submission of request for 'admission cancellation form' from the candidate. Such candidates have to apply in the prescribed form for cancellation of admission and for collecting the documents candidate will have to report personally with the original Admission Allotment Letter issued at the time of Counseling/Admission as mandatory document.

19. For admission process if the number of applications received / eligible are less than the available seats, then the rights to conduct special CET are reserved with college administration.

20. The final authority to take decision, in case of any problem related to Common Entrance Test / admission process arise / or any complaint done, will be Hon. Principal, New Arts, Commerce and Science College. Applicant is bound to the decision given by Hon. Principal Sir.
